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## EDUCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

### PART I - REQUIREMENTS FOR APPLICANTS

In order to be considered for an educational scholarship, an applicant must meet the following requirements:

1. Applicant must be a member of Connection Hill Church and in good standing. (A member in good standing is defined as one who has been a member for at least one (1) year and has not been absent from church services for an entire month (30 days) for any period during the calendar year unless they are away in school.)
2. Show proof of enrollment or include a letter of acceptance at an accredited institution of higher learning along with grades and class schedules. To receive full scholarship, applicants must be enrolled a minimum of 12 hours per semester, or 6 hours per quarter, and maintain a GPA of 2.0.
3. Applicants will be eligible to receive scholarships for either two or four years, based on the program of study upon enrollment. Scholarship will be awarded for the school year, and will be paid 50% for fall semester, and 50% for spring semester, provided the student is in good standing in school, and church and meeting all requirements. If a student is not enrolled for the minimum semester hours, they will receive one half the approved amount. If a student does not complete the semester in which funds are given and does not have a reasonable explanation for not completing the term, they will be ineligible for scholarship the next semester ("reasonable explanation" will be determined by the committee).
4. Complete and sign Part I of the Scholarship Application. Submit the completed application and supporting documentation to the Scholarship Committee by the deadline. (including completed interview questionnaire and evaluation)
5. **Deadline for submission:** To be considered for the upcoming semester, all Scholarship applications must be received by the 1st Sunday in July. They can either be placed in the designated drop box or forwarded by U.S. Mail.
6. All Scholarship Recipients are expected to be involved in church activities and to attend regularly when they are not in school to remain in good standing. Church activities include Sunday School, Worship Services, Bible Study, Youth/Young Adult activities and participation in Scholarship fundraising events.
7. Progress reports including grades and class schedules are required regardless of the current situation. They are to be turned in no later than December 31<sup>st</sup> and May 31<sup>st</sup>.
8. As Young Adults, the applicants are expected to take responsibility for all aspects of the application process and communication with the committee (e-mail, fax, telephone, etc). The committee will not consider any request received from parents. However, parents will be expected to meet with the Committee during the interview process and to participate during the year in fundraising events.

**Failure to meet any of the established requirements will make you ineligible for scholarships.**
